Programme Structure for 2017-18 Intake (4-year curriculum)

The student-designed major is open to outstanding students admitted to the Faculty of Arts. The 48 credits for the student-designed major will normally comprise courses offered by departments in the Faculty of Arts and a minimum of 24 credits should comprise courses at the 3000 or 4000 level. With approval of the Dean, up to 12 credits of the major may be taken outside the Arts Faculty.
