Language of Instruction for Taught Postgraduate Programmes

1. The Research and Postgraduate Studies Committee (RPSC)* decided at its January 2008 meeting that flexibility should be given to individual taught postgraduate programmes to declare their language of instruction.

2. Academic units offering taught postgraduate programmes should however be reminded of the importance of language of instruction to student learning. Specifically, academic units concerned shall
 - a. declare the overall language of instruction policy of the programme in the publicity materials (e.g. most courses taught in English and a few electives in Chinese);

 - b. in case there is a student on the programme who does not know Chinese, there should be sufficient number of courses to be taught in English for choice of student; and

 - c. language of instruction of courses should be indicated clearly in advance for students' knowledge.
