## **Language of Instruction for Taught Postgraduate Programmes**

- 1. The Research and Postgraduate Studies Committee (RPSC)\* decided at its January 2008 meeting that flexibility should be given to individual taught postgraduate programmes to declare their language of instruction.
- 2. Academic units offering taught postgraduate programmes should however be reminded of the importance of language of instruction to student learning. Specifically, academic units concerned shall
  - a. declare the overall language of instruction policy of the programme in the publicity materials (e.g. most courses taught in English and a few electives in Chinese);
  - b. in case there is a student on the programme who does not know Chinese, there should be sufficient number of courses to be taught in English for choice of student; and
  - c. language of instruction of courses should be indicated clearly in advance for students' knowledge.
