

## **The Lingnan University Entrance Scholarships for BA (Hons) in Global Liberal Arts Programme**

### **1. Background**

The Lingnan University Entrance Scholarships for BA (Hons) in Global Liberal Arts Programme will be awarded to local new admittees to the BA (Hons) in Global Liberal Arts Programme (GLAP) at Lingnan via JUPAS and Non-JUPAS admissions, starting from the academic year of 2020-2021, for an initial period of 3 years.

### **2. Eligibility and Criteria**

The eligibility and criteria the entrance scholarships are as follows:

- The scholarships shall be awarded to full-time local students (permanent residents in HKSAR) admitted to the GLAP on the basis of their academic merits, and selection interview performance if necessary.
- Up to 5 students who have achieved 22.00 or above in the summation of the scores of the best 5 subjects in HKDSE without subject weightings, or a total admission score of a minimum result of 30 or above in International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma shall be each awarded scholarships amounted to HK\$25,000 per academic year. (The scholarship quotas will be shared between eligible HKDSE takers and IB Diploma holders and adjusted flexibly if needed.)
- Up to 5 students who have achieved 20.00 or 21.00 in the summation of the scores of the best 5 subjects in HKDSE without subject weightings shall be each awarded scholarships amounted to HK\$15,000 per academic year.
- The admission scores could be obtained in multiple sittings.
- A cumulative GPA of 3.0 is required for the annual renewal of the scholarships throughout the 4-year study.
