

Targeted Taught Postgraduate Programmes Fellowships Scheme

The “Targeted Taught Postgraduate Programmes Fellowships Scheme” is introduced by the HKSAR Government with the aim to attract meritorious local students to pursue further studies in priority areas conducive to the strategic development of Hong Kong. Administered under the University Grant Committee (UGC), fellowship places have been allocated for the MACAH programme in the 2021/22 academic year.

Eligibility

Local students are all eligible for the fellowship, both full-time and part-time modes;

Students awarded with other government scholarships, including the Continuing Education Fund, will not be considered to avoid “double benefit”. Nevertheless, students are still eligible to apply for the Extended Non-means tested Loan Scheme under Student Finance Office to settle the tuition fees for the TPG programme in the form of loans.

Amonnt

The fellowship students are required to pay a minimum tuition fee of **HK\$42,100**, which is the prevailing rate of the UGC-funded programmes, and the differences will be subsidised by the fellowship subject to a cap of **HK\$120,000** for each student regardless of the actual study period of the programme. For MACAH programme, the tuition fee for 2021/22 academic year is HK\$135,000, then the level of the fellowship will be capped at **HK\$92,900**.

Award

The fellowship will be based on merits taking into account the students’ academic achievements, professional qualifications, relevant working experience and achievements as well as the proposals submitted by the students with special attention to their **personal statements** on how they can contribute to art and culture of Hong Kong after completing the programme.

Application

Eligible applicants who are admitted to MACAH will be invited by the Programme Office to submit applications for the Fellowships Scheme.
